Quick Tip When PC is Hung

Try pressing the Num Lock button on the keyboard and watching the Num Lock led to see if it turns off and on.

If you're able to get the Num Lock led to turn off/on, press CTRL + ALT + DEL and End the frozen program.

If you are <u>unable</u> to turn the Num Lock led on/off. then Windows itself is hung and you need to reboot.

- 2. On the Advanced Boot Options screen, use the arrow keys to highlight Repair your computer, and then press Enter.
- 3. You can also create a system repair disc that contains the System Recovery Options menu. For more information, Create a system repair disc.
- 4. On the System Recovery Options menu, click Startup Repair
- 5. Windows 7 System Recovery Options

- 2. Press the Windows + C keys to open the Charms bar. Next, tap or click Settings, and then tap or click Change PC Settings, and then select General. Under Advanced startup, tap or click the Restart now button.
