1. ANTI-MALWARE SCANS & SECURITY PROGRAMS:

- a. Verify the following programs are all installed. If not, download and install them.
☐ SAS (*Super Anti Spyware*) ☐ MBAM - MalwareBytes AntiMalware ☐ SANDBOXIE
- b. Disable the REAL-TIME PROTECTION in any Anti-virus Programs.
- c. Make sure the Windows Firewall is turned on. (*Control Panel > Windows Firewall*). *A third party firewall is OK, but not recommended.*
- d. SAS STAND-ALONE SCAN (*SuperAntiSpyware*): Download the latest version, then run a full scan.
- e. MBAM SCAN: (*MalwareBytes AntiMalware*) Do on-line updates, then run a full scan.
- f. MBAR SCAN: (*MalwareBytes Anti Rootkit*) Do on-line updates, then run a scan.
- g. SPYBOT S&D: Do on-line updates, Immunize, then run a scan.
- h. MSE SCAN: (*or desired AV suite*) Make sure it is up to date, then run a full-scan

2. HARD-DRIVE HEALTH: Install if necessary: ☐ HD TUNE ☐ CRYSTAL DISK INFO

- a. ☐ Run HDTUNE & verify that ☐ Health Status is OK. *If "Health" is questionable, install & run "Crystal Disk Info" to verify.* ☐ Run the benchmark speed test: _____MB/sec.
- b. ☐ Run the long Error Scan (Not quick) & verify that blocks are all green. (*If not, run chkdsk /f /r*).

3. IMAGE BACKUP

- a. Verify there is adequate free space on the external hard-drive, then do an Image backup.

4. REMOVE OLD PROGRAMS.

- a. Remove Shockwave, and all old versions of Adobe Reader, FLASH FF, FLASH IE, & all JAVA's.
- b. With User's permission, remove any unnecessary programs, toolbars, or desktop search programs

5. UTILITY PROGRAMS:

- a. Verify the latest version of these utilities are installed:
☐ BELARC ADVISOR ☐ CCLEANER ☐ Codestuff STARTER
☐ REVO UNINSTALLER ☐ SECUNIA PSI ☐ SPEEDFAN ☐ TFC Temp File Cleaner

6. HARDWARE INSPECTION:

- a. PC TEMPERATURES: Run the SpeedFan Utility to benchmark PC temperatures. Core=_____°C
- b. AIR FLOW: Inspect all fans, intake grills, outgo grills, and heatsink fins. Clean as necessary. Note: If the PC has a separate Video card, be sure its heatsink is VERY clean. Many GPU's run too hot.

7. TEST THE INTERNET CONNECTION & SPEED. Using a wired & wireless network, check the speed of the internet connection. _____kbps download **WIRED**, _____kbps **WIRELESS**.

8. WINDOWS UPDATE:

- a. SETTINGS: Verify the "Windows Update" screen settings are correct. (*Click Control Panel > System and Security > System > Windows Updates > Change Settings*). Verify all boxes are checked, especially Microsoft Update.
- b. Run CHECK FOR UPDATES: Install all Important, Recommended, and Optional Updates.
- c. Optional Hardware Driver updates, USE CAUTION: These can be a LOWER Level than is already installed on the PC. If a lower level, "Hide" them, do not install them.
- d. Keep re-running "Check for Updates" until no more updates are found.

9. SECUNIA PSI SCAN: Verify version _____. Run a scan to see if any programs are insecure or

10. **CLEAN "TEMP" FILES, COOKIES, ETC:**
 - a. TFC: Close all programs and run the "Temp File Cleaner" utility (*This will reboot the system*).
 - b. CCLEANER SCAN: Update CCleaner, then For each User, run "file clean". FILES cleaned: _____ MB
11. **DEVICE MANAGER ISSUES:** Make sure there are no devices with Exclamation marks, Question marks, or X's. If you see any exceptions, **fix all issues before continuing!**
12. **HARD DRIVE DATA CHECKOUT:** (From an Administrator Account)
 - a. **ADEQUATE FREE SPACE:** Verify there is a minimum of 15% free-space on drive C). _____ GB Free
 - b. **DEFRAG:** Make sure the auto-defrag schedule is set up properly.
13. **DISABLE AUTOPLAY:** Turn off AutoPlay for all devices. (*Control Panel > Hardware and sound > AutoPlay*). Un-check the box: "☐ Use AutoPlay for all media & devices". Then select for Audio CD's and DVD's, "Play with Windows Media Player" (or as desired), and click "Save".
14. **START MENU:**
 - a. Turn off "Highlight newly installed programs". (*Right-click START > Properties > Customize*). Uncheck the box for "☐ Highlight newly installed programs".
 - b. Verify the "All Programs" Menu is tall enough. If not, tune it up per my "Start menu Customizations" sheet for Windows 7.
15. **TASKBAR:**
 - a. TASKBAR LOCKED: Verify the Taskbar is Locked. (*Right-click the Task bar*)
 - b. NOTIFICATION AREA: (*Right-click Start > Properties > Taskbar tab > Notification Area > Customize*). Check the box for "☒ Always Show all icons and notifications on the taskbar".
16. **INTERNET EXPLORER:** Do the first-use set up. Verify Cache size: (*Tools > Internet Options > General Tab. Under Browsing History, click Settings > select 50 MB*). Secure IE by setting up Delete on exit: (*Tools > Internet Options > General Tab > check the box for "☒ Delete Browsing History on exit*).
17. **CLEAN-UP E-MAIL FOLDERS:** Remove attachments, delete/archive old emails, empty the Trash folder, and compact all folders. (*See my "SPEED UP WINDOWS 7" sheet at www.jimopi.com for instructions*)
18. **MULTIMEDIA UTILITIES:** Make sure the latest versions of these programs are installed:
 - a. ☐ JAVA ☐ FLASH for FIREFOX ☐ FLASH for IE
 - b. ☐ WINDOWS MEDIA PLAYER 12.
 - 1) MENUS: Right-click in the menu area and select "View". If "Show Menu bar" is not already checked, check it.
 - 2) Verify the usage rights option is off. Click (*Tools > Options > "Privacy" tab*), and make sure box for "☐ Download usage rights automatically..." is UN-CHECKED.
19. **BELARC ADVISOR:** Make sure it is the latest version, run a pass, and save the results to a Flash-drive. Fix any issues.
20. **SECURITY:**
 - a. Re-enable REAL-TIME PROTECTION. (*Note: Only one program should be running real-time protection*).
 - b. Verify these are installed & up-to-date: ☐ WOT for IE, ☐ WOT for Firefox, & ☐ SANDBOXIE
 - c. Make sure the Windows Firewall is turned on. (*Control Panel > Windows Firewall*). A third party firewall is OK, but not recommended. **NOTE: Some A/V suites prevent the Windows Firewall from being turned on.**
21. **ACTION CENTER (Vista = Security Center):** Open Action Center and make sure there are no warnings or error messages.
22. **MAKE SURE THE CD/DVD DRIVE IS EMPTY and YOUR FLASH DRIVE IS REMOVED!**
